



INSTALLATION GUIDE

Hang it once. Let it fall beautifully.

A practical sequence for preparing the room, securing the hardware, protecting the fabric, and finishing the folds.

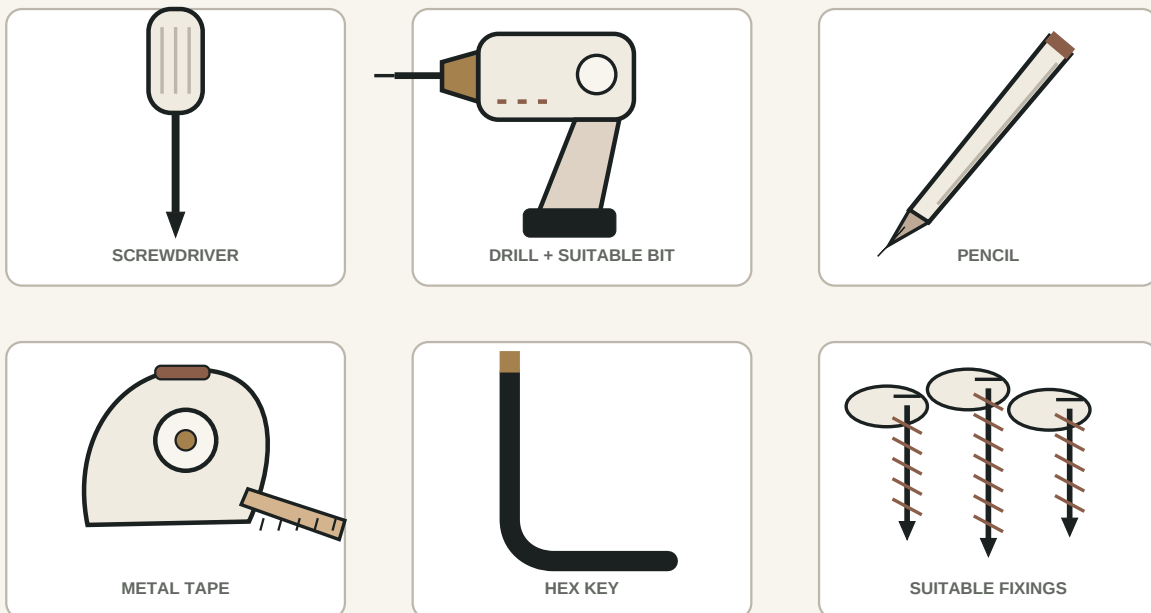
BEFORE YOU BEGIN

Prepare the right tools before the first hole.

Lay out the tools specified with your hardware, then match every fixing to the wall construction and treatment weight.

INSTALLATION / 01A

Prepare the right tools



Use wall-appropriate fixings and the tools specified with your hardware.

CHECK BEFORE DRILLING

Add a long or laser level, a stable step ladder, a clean protective sheet, and a second person. Read the product-specific fixing schedule before selecting bits or anchors.

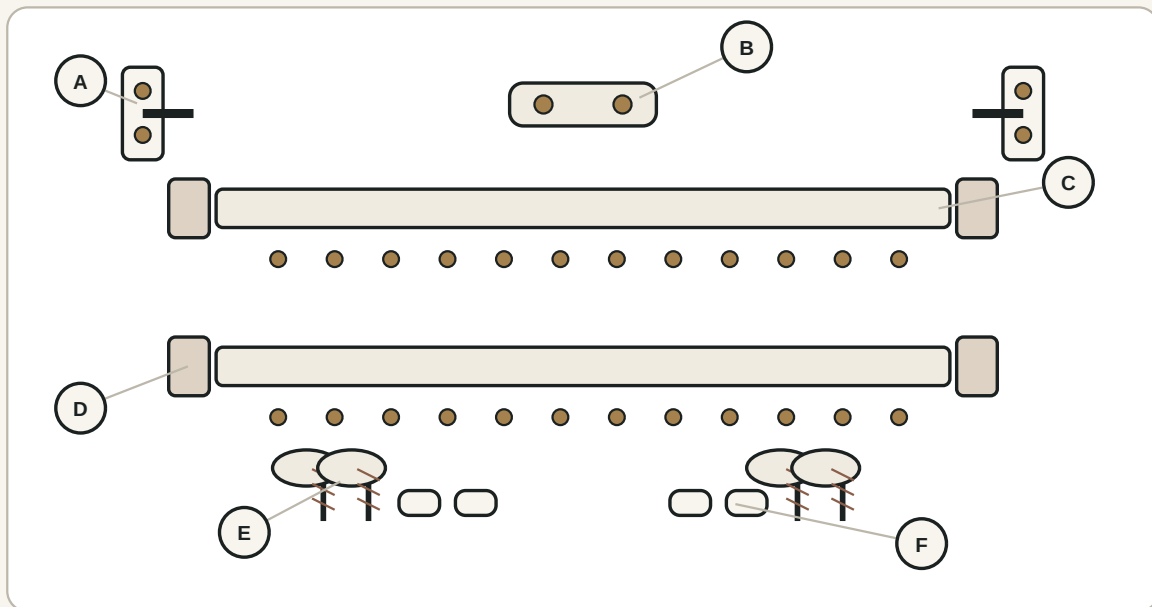
STEP 01 / PREPARE

Unpack, identify, and protect the fabric.

Lay the panels on a clean, dry surface and confirm the hardware, heading, and panel count against the order.

INSTALLATION / 01B

Identify the supplied accessories



A Brackets

B Connector or joiner

C Rail or rod sections

D End stops or covers

E Screws and anchors

F Carriers or hooks

EXAMPLE ONLY - CONTENTS VARY

- Keep packaging until the installation is complete.
- Protect light fabric from tools, floor dust, and drilling debris.
- Separate left and right panels if they are labeled.

BEFORE DRILLING

Check for concealed wiring, plumbing, and obstacles. If the wall construction is uncertain, use a qualified installer.

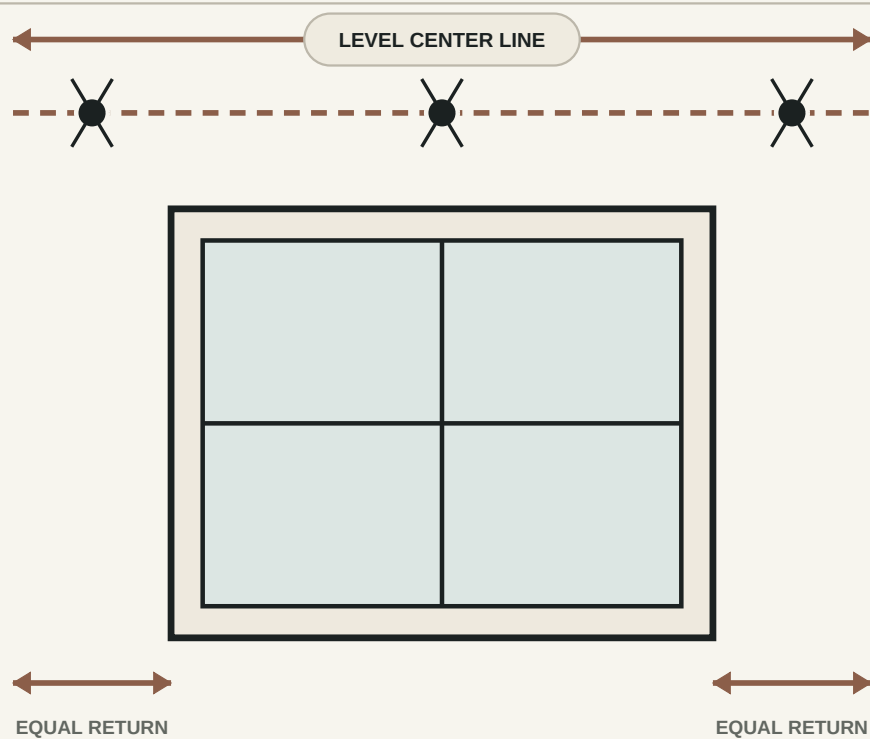
STEP 02 / MARK

Transfer the approved position to the wall.

Use the approved measurements to mark the center line and bracket positions. Check height and symmetry from the room.

INSTALLATION / 02

Transfer the approved position



- Use a long level or laser level.
- Confirm equal returns on both sides.
- Dry-fit the hardware before making every hole.

VISUAL CHECK

Step back and compare the marks with the ceiling, trim, and nearby furniture before drilling.

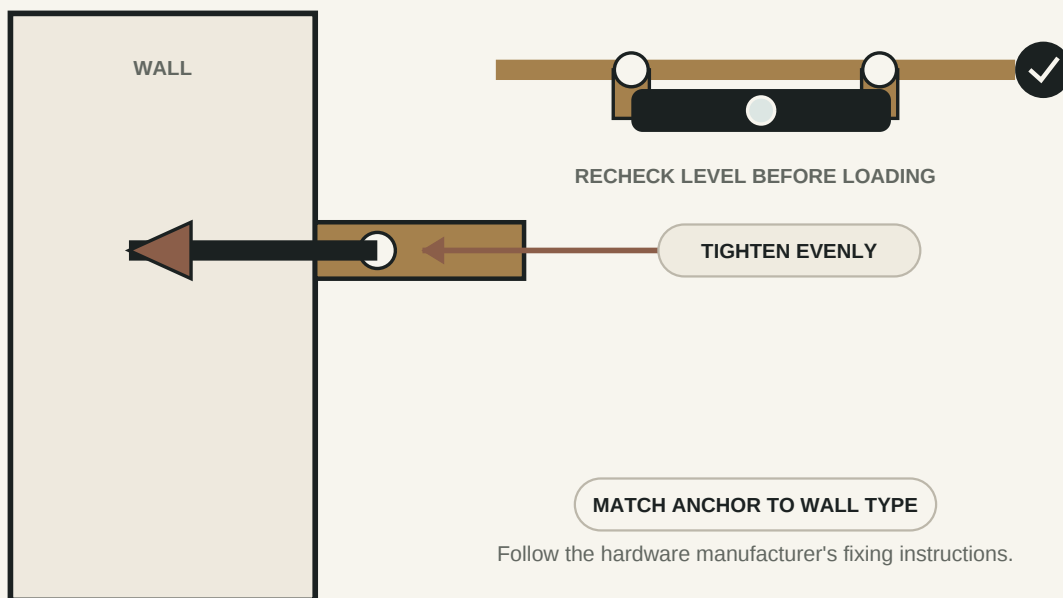
STEP 03 / SECURE

Install the brackets or track firmly and level.

Follow the hardware manufacturer's instructions and use fixings suited to the mounting surface and treatment weight.

INSTALLATION / 03

Secure the hardware firmly and level



- Tighten every fixing evenly.
- Recheck level after the first and final bracket.
- Test the unloaded rod or track before hanging fabric.

PRODUCT-SPECIFIC SPACING

Use the spacing and fixing schedule supplied with your VeloFold hardware. Do not copy dimensions from another product system.

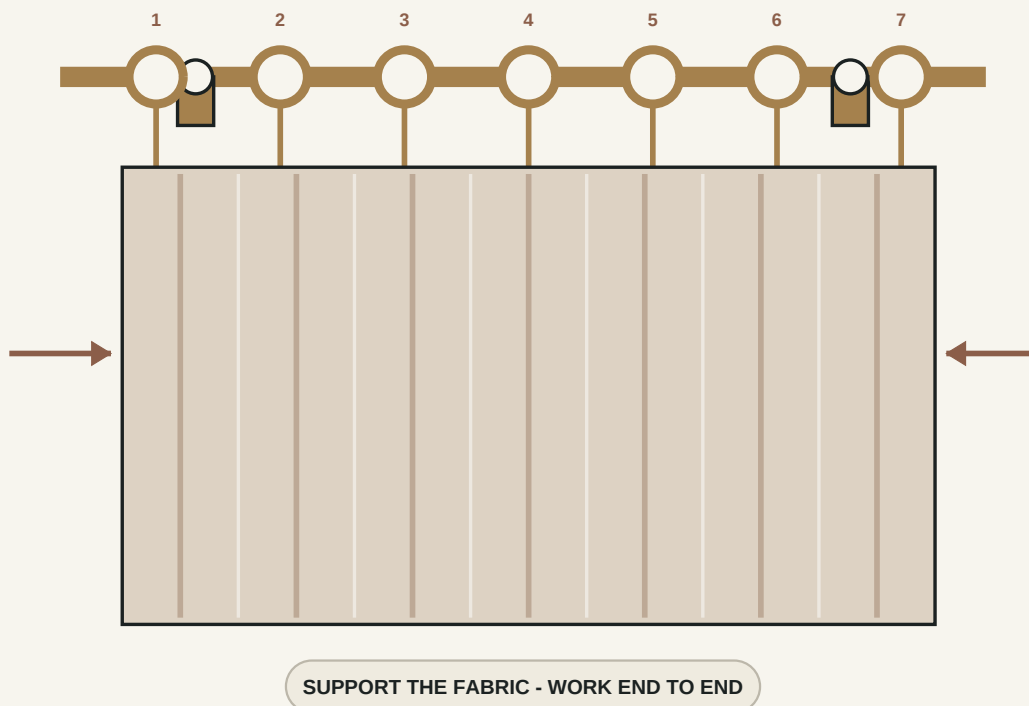
STEP 04 / HANG

Load the panels without twisting the heading.

Work from one end to the other, supporting the fabric as each hook, ring, or carrier is attached.

INSTALLATION / 04

Attach every hook, ring, or carrier



- Keep spacing consistent across the heading.
- Make sure every hook or carrier is fully seated.
- Open and close the treatment slowly for the first test.

PROTECT THE HEM

Do not drag the panel across the floor. A second person should support the lower fabric while the heading is attached.

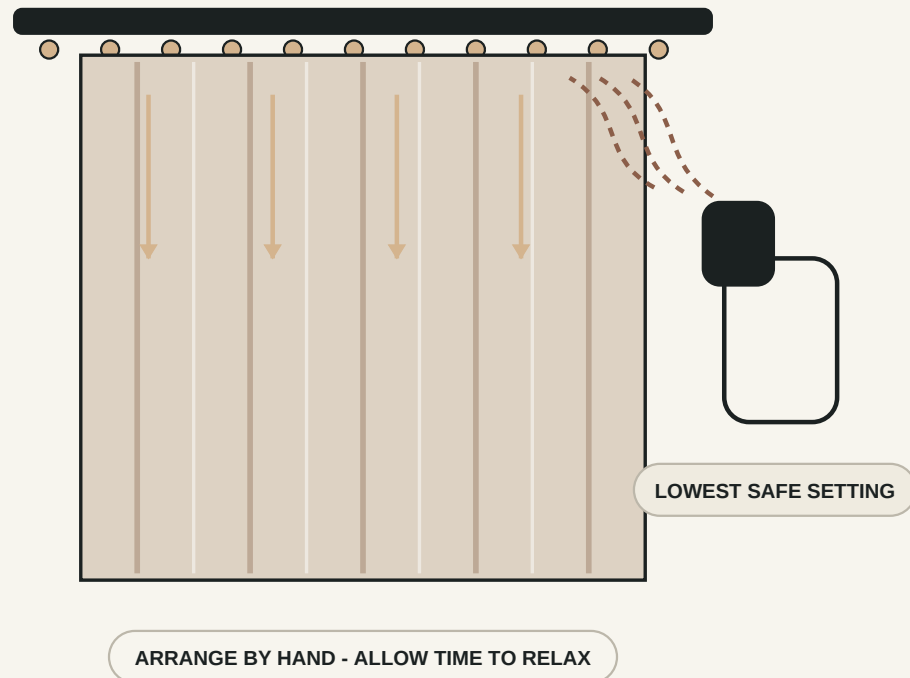
STEP 05 / FINISH

Train the folds and let the fabric settle.

Arrange the folds by hand, then lightly steam from the reverse side only if the care instructions allow it.

INSTALLATION / 05

Train the folds and let the fabric settle



- Start with the lowest safe steam setting.
- Keep the steamer moving and avoid direct contact.
- Leave the treatment closed briefly to encourage consistent folds.

NATURAL SETTLING

Made-to-order drapery can relax over several days. Revisit the folds after the fabric has adjusted to the room.

FINAL CHECK

Hardware secure. Fabric protected.

Complete a slow test before the installation is considered finished.

01 Hardware
All fixings are firm, suitable for the wall, and level.

02 Movement
The treatment opens and closes without catching or twisting.

03 Fabric
The hem is clean, the panels are supported, and the folds are arranged.

04 Controls
Cords, wands, motors, charging access, and stops are safe and reachable.

05 Room
Tools and packaging are removed and the installation area is clean.

When the wall or hardware is uncertain, pause and ask.
